From food and wine aficionados to those looking for a unique, close-to-home “travel” experience, Passport to Sonoma Valley swings open the cellar doors of California’s oldest and most coveted artisan wineries in celebration of Sonoma’s food, wine and arts scene. Visitors to the valley-wide open house will be issued a “passport”, providing them unprecedented access to the wines and wineries of California’s oldest wine region, including special pricing and exclusive wine offers.

Tickets for Passport to Sonoma Valley are: \$90/weekend, \$70/ Sunday-Only and \$25/designated driver when purchased in advance or \$100/weekend and \$80/Sunday-Only and \$25/designated driver when purchased at the event (subject to availability).
